Your primary role is to make sure the youth's voice drives the direction of the conversation. You do not need to be the youth's permanency option to participate.

You are trusted. You are valued. **You are VERY important.**

We need you to help make sure the conversation doesn't get taken over by other agendas, as well-intentioned as they may be. What does that mean? It means that if people want to talk about behaviors, or medication, or education plans, or any other number of things, that you keep the conversation focused on permanency, with the youth driving the conversation.

Youth deserve real and meaningful discussions about the relationships and connections they will need to be successful in life. Life skills alone don't matter without people to hold you accountable and provide you with a sense of belonging.

Everyone is worthy of family.

Your seat at this table can make all the difference.

The table is set.




